Home educating involves effective learning that is time-consuming and requires effort. By trying to get around this process only minimizes the quality of education the student receives. Guilford Christian Academy requires enrolled families and students to agree to the following guidelines. Please check to acknowledge you have read and understand these guidelines.

- A student's work, assignments and/or tests must be graded by a parent or other qualified person.
- All final course grades must be based on scored work; you may create your own evaluation form or rubrics. Discuss with the student how you are going to grade them so they can focus on what's important. Unschoolers may keep records of what has been worked on and record appropriately.
- If a test is taken over to improve a grade, both tests' grades must be averaged. The averaged grade is then the one submitted. If a number of tests are taken to determine a grade for a chapter, take the average of all the tests or the average of the first and last tests.
- Open book tests are considered reviews and the scores should not be used for a grade.
- Honest documentation is expected; please ask for assistance if you need some guidance in this area. We have forms available to help you keep records.
